Step aside: The importance of side-stepping for children with neurodisability

Hip displacement is one of the most common issues affecting children with a neurodisability, warranting continuous monitoring and carefully planned interventions to prevent secondary complications and aid joint development. In children who are following a typical development timeline, cruising and side-stepping strengthens muscles around the hips which aids hip joint development and acts as an important precursor for independent mobility.

Children with additional needs often require extra input to strengthen their hip abductor muscles. In this talk, we will explore how side-stepping movements contribute to improving hip strength, gait and overall function. 
