Language is more than words, it's how we connect, learn, grow, and stay safe. For many disabled childrer and adults, Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) is the key that unlocks this vital part of being human

In this session, we'll explore how AAC can bring language to life for those who cannot always rely on speech. We'll discuss why language access is not a luxury, but a fundamental right one that empowers individuals to express who they are, build relationships, and navigate the world on their own torms.

1:00pm Sling Selection

This session will cover all the factors that should be considered when prescribing a sling for a client. It will include sling sizing, hoist/sling compatibility, the transfer being executed, client's presentation (medical needs, postural needs, skir integrity, fluctuating condition, size and shape), LOLER, what to include on the handling plan and wider considerations.

Delegates who are professionals will be able to integrate the information to inform their assessments and prescription, ensuring they are following best practice. Parents, carers and others will have an understanding of all the factors the professional has to consider in the assessment process to help them better understand why a particular sling has been prescribed. They will also be able to use this information to inform the professional involved in the care of the individual if they feel current prescription is no longer meeting need or LOLER requirements.




